CITY OF MURRAY HILL MINUTES February 13, 2024

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm, by Mayor Johnson in an activities room at New Life Church. Commissioners present were Kaelin, Rieser, Bennett and Watson. Also, in attendance was City Clerk/Treasurer Barker and residents Howard Wardell and Kent Hall.

Those in attendance were led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

The agenda was presented and approved.

The Minutes of the January 2024 meeting were presented and a motion was made to approve. The motion was seconded and it was approved unanimously.

The lights in the island have been repaired and they are all working.

One tree will be delivered to the common area and will be planted shortly. The small tree that was recently planted will be moved. It was suggested that in the Spring the board should walk the path and check for any cleanup that needs to be done.

Discussion took place about finalizing where to disperse cash assets. There was a motion to move \$200,000 to Stock Yards Bank on a 7-month CD at 5%. The motion was seconded and it passed unanimously. The money will be moved. The distribution of the other \$200,000 will be decided at the March meeting.

The flyer announcing the date and time of the Easter Egg Hunt will go out shortly. The date is March 24 from 2 to 3 o'clock.

Howard Wardell talked about some changes he is planning for the container that is sitting on his property. Commissioner Kaelin explained the history of the city's follow up to complaints in reference to this container. The changes would not put this container in compliance. The fine for this violation will begin on February 15, 2024.

A motion was made to go into executive session. It was seconded and approved unanimously.

The General meeting reconvened.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned. The next regular meeting will be March 12, 2024 in an activity room at New Life Church at 6:30 p.m.
